Insurance: Neither the Elyria City Health Department nor Student Health will bill your insurance company for vaccination charges. You will need to pay and then submit the receipt to your insurance company for reimbursement. Many health insurance plans, including the Oberlin Student Health Plan, will not cover travel vaccinations because they are not “necessary.” The insurers’ reasoning seems to be that you could just stay home and not need the shots. Your insurance is more likely to cover shots that are recommended within the United States. Consult your plan to determine which, if any, vaccinations may be covered
